## DISTRIBUTION LIST December 2012

The **AATTC Distribution Service** aims to supply as many current Australian timetables and information brochures as possible. It also provides historical material from Australia and overseas as it becomes available.

### How the Distribution Service functions

New arrangements for Distribution Service were approved at the November 2012 AATTC Committee meeting.

A new position of Distribution Manager has been created. He is responsible for collating the various compilations of Distribution List items, receiving and recording the orders, and allocating them to the various Distribution Officers for despatch. This position is currently vacant, and anyone who may be interested in it should contact the President, Victor Isaacs. For the time being, Treasurer Len Regan is acting as Distribution Manager.

There are several Distribution Officers around the country who collect material for the Distribution List, compile the Distribution List for these items, and despatch the orders for these items. Hence, members will receive their orders from several different sources.

The Distribution Officers responsible for Distribution List items are shown by a code in the first column of the List.

All credit balances carry over into the new arrangements. The Treasurer will handle records of payments and the management of individual credit accounts.

- **Date:** The start date for the service, otherwise the print date shown the item. ( ) Exact Date Unknown
- **Status:** **O:** Original (or image copy of original quality). **Bc:** B&W image copy or print. **Cc:** colour print copy. **Web:** Print from website.  
**CF:** Computer file. **CD, DVD:** Computer disc. **C:** Current. **NC:** Not Current. **?:** Current status not known
- **Size:** Finished page size. **DL, DLX, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, B5:** Standard paper sizes. + or -: larger or smaller than standard size. **FCap:** Foolscap  
**2A4:** Half A4. **4A4, 4A3:** Quarter A4, A3 (A4, A3 folded longways). Non-standard sizes are shown in millimetres.  
**P:** Pocket size (~80x145mm). **W:** Wallet size (~65x95mm). **M:** Mini size (credit card). **F:** Folded
- **Pages:** Number of pages if stapled or glued.

**Orders placed by email** will be acknowledged within 5 days. If no acknowledgement is received, please re-send the order, as there may have been a breakdown in email transmission.

**Limited Stock** items are marked with an \* in the first column in the Distribution List, beside the Item Number.

If there are more orders than the available stock, a ballot will be held on 15 December 2012.

Credit for the cost of the item will be granted to those who are unsuccessful in the ballot.

**Payments** for orders can be made by postage stamps, by money order or cheque payable to Australian Association of Timetable Collectors (AATTC), by PayPal to AATTC at aattc.do@hunterlink.net.au, or by EFT bank deposit to AATTC: Westpac BSB 034083, account 163088.

**Discounts** are available to AATTC members:

- 5% for orders over \$10.00
- Additional 5% for large orders over \$30, subject to adequate coverage of costs.

**Contributions** to the Distribution Service are always welcome. Please contact the Distribution Manager (currently the Treasurer) for information on where to send the material. Contact details are on page 1.

There are several ways in which this can be done.

- If you can send single copies of timetables and brochures, arrangements can then usually be made to request more copies from the operator.
- If you can obtain multiple copies, usually 10 copies are needed to cater for orders, but 15 copies are needed if the item is likely to be popular.

You can request to have the cost of postage for sending supplies for the Distribution Service granted as credit to your account.
