Please make sure that it is clear which item numbers you are ordering. If an item is available in both file and print versions, as shown in the right hand columns, please clearly indicate which version you want. Files are normally sent by email, but can be posted on a CD for an extra \$2.50.

Please include an email address or phone number so that Peter can check any order details if necessary.

Please contact Peter **if you do not receive your order within two weeks for email orders or three weeks for postage orders**.

Peter will forward your order to the Distribution Officers who hold the stock for the items ordered, and they will despatch the items. Their codes are shown in the first column of the Distribution List.

Payments attached to orders will be forwarded to the Treasurer.

**Costs:** Each item is allocated a number of cost points, each worth 25 cents. Add up the cost points for the items you order, and divide by 4 to work out the total dollar value of your order. The cost of packing and postage is included in these costs.

ATA members get a discount of 5% for Distribution List orders for over \$10, and 10% for orders over \$30 subject to adequate coverage of costs.
